

PPE training (beta): Two-player game to practice doffing of Personal Protective Equipment. Designed to prepare healthcare professionals for emergencies involving patients with highly-infectious diseases.

Based on CDC's August 2015 Ebola guidelines.



3D Simulations of doffing procedures.

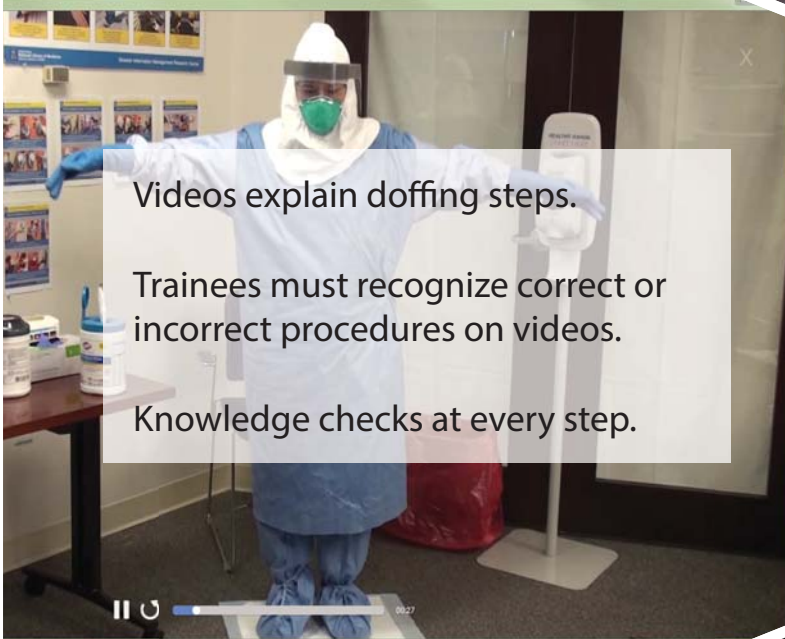
Highly interactive, collaborative exercises.

One player plays a caregiver, the other an observer ("buddy").

Requires two networked computers.

This step has been

1. Engage Trained Observer
2. Inspect
3. Disinfect Outer Gloves
Disinfect outer-gloved hands with alcohol-based rub (ABHR)
4. Remove Apron (if used)
5. Inspect
6. Disinfect and Remove
7. Inspect, Disinfect, and
8. Remove Face Shield



Videos explain doffing steps.

Trainees must recognize correct or incorrect procedures on videos.

Knowledge checks at every step.
